#### INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

### **Establishment of Ex Servicemen Workshop(ESMW)**

### An Entrepreneurial Self Sustaining Venture to be run by ESM

#### Introduction

- 1. Indian Army, invites Expression of Interest (EoI) from the eligible and interested ESM for interaction on establishing envisaged ESM run Workshops under aegis of DGR for the scheme titled 'Ex-Servicemen Workshop Scheme'. Based on response of ESM to EoI, the envisaged ESMW Scheme will be finalised and run as any other DGR schemes for ESM.
- 2. The purpose of the invitation for Expression of Interest (EoI) is to discuss and identify the aspirations of prospective **ESM/ body of ESM** for undertaking establishment and running of ESM workshops at prospective locations, where consequent to optimization of Station Workshops, requirement of a dependable and reliable engineering support eco system is felt by the Local Military Authorities.
- 3. The scheme envisages repair of vehicles (COTS, multi brand) of Armed Forces Units functioning on Peace Establishment (PE) by ESM Workshops through **Service Level Agreements.** Once the repair setup stabilizes, based on requirement, the facilities can be extended to other co-located Govt Organisations like-Central/ State Government offices, Hospitals and Schools. To make the proposal financially viable, option of undertaking repair of personal vehicles/ two wheelers, associated ancillary jobs like seat repair, welding, denting/ painting etc may also be considered. Further the scope of repairs may also be expanded in an incremental manner to cover the entire range of equipment, like IT equipment, generators, ACs, mobiles etc held with units/ establishments working on Peace Establishment (PE). The aim would be to develop it as a **One Stop Repair Destination**.
- 4. Only ESM, in individual capacity or as a body of ESM are eligible to respond to this Eol. For explanation of Ex-Servicemen, refer "**Definition of Ex-Servicemen**" on the website of Directorate General Resettlement, Department of Ex-Servicemen (MoD) (https://www.dgrindia.com).
- 5. The broad scope of work of ESMW is briefly described in the following sections.

#### **Overview of the Concept**

- 6. Consequent to optimization of Station Workshops, there is requirement of a dependable and reliable engineering support eco system for undertaking repair of vehicles/ equipment of units/ establishments functioning on Peace Establishment (PE). Creation of Ex Servicemen run Workshops is one such viable option, which can not only provide a one stop solution for maintenance and repair of equipment of non-field force, but also offer a second career to skilled ESM of Armed Forces.
- 7. <u>ESM Venture</u>. It is an envisaged self-sustained Entrepreneurial Venture, to be run exclusively by ESM by forming a Society/ Pvt Ltd Company or similar models. Being an exclusive ESM project, based upon the requirement and response, DGR would formalize guideline/ procedures in consultation with the Directorate General of EME. The venture is aimed to serve equipment sustenance needs of the Armed Forces in peace stations as per a long term subsidized rate repair contract. The facilities on need basis may also be extended to other co-located Govt Organisations and private vehicles. In an overall analysis, it has to be a self-reliant scalable ESM entrepreneurial venture with ownership of the ESM who operate the Workshop. The profit or loss, success or failure, scalability or status quo and all activities of the Workshop will be entrusted to the ESM/ ESM team.
- 8. To gauge response and expectations of ESM from the envisaged ESMW Scheme formulated by the Dte Gen of EME in consultation with DGR, interaction will be carried out with respondents of the Eol. Being first of its kind and an ESM Venture, initial hand holding would be considered as per the existing regulations on the subject in vogue. To ensure effective and efficient launch of the project, leveraging experience and expertise of established market players, through appropriate collaboration may also be considered by the ESM lead.

### **Broad Scope of Work**

- 9. The ESM Workshop will be required to carry out repair of vehicles/ equipment as per OEM or equivalent to OEM repair standards. The repair methodology to be adopted should be as designated in the applicable Repair/ Technical manuals. The envisaged scope of work is as given below:-
  - (a) <u>Initial</u>. Vehicles (multi-brand) repairs/ periodic servicing, denting/ painting, welding, Value Added Services like wheel balancing, toe-in/ toe-out, pollution control checks, recovery/ in-situ repairs and any other allied services considered essential by the Local Military Authority (LMA) and ESM Coy running ESMW.
  - (b) <u>Subsequent Equipment Spectrum</u>. Once established, based on requirement repair facilities can be scaled up in range and scope in an incremental manner like capability to undertake repair of generators, IT equipment, Air Conditioners, Mobiles etc.
- 10. In order to achieve better customer satisfaction, the ESM Workshop will be at liberty to improve the repair process, where required or not defined and implement it. Any such improvements will be under the overall ambit of the ESM Workshop mandate and the adopted model.

- 11. <u>Service Level Agreement (SLA) and Clientele</u>. As the project envisages improving employment opportunities of ESM and the venture would primarily serve the equipment sustenance needs of the Armed Forces and on required basis can be extended to co-located paramilitary forces/ Central and State Govt Offices, schools etc, entering into Service Level Agreement can be considered. The envisaged clientele for the ESMW Scheme are as follows:-
  - (a) All vehicles (multi-brand) of Armed Forces units in Station on Peace Establishment.
  - (b) On stabilization, **based on requirement**, the facilities may be extended to other co-located Govt Organisations, Central/ State Government offices, Hospitals, Schools etc.
  - (c) Private/ personal vehicles.
- 12. <u>Mode of Payment</u>. As per the existing provisions applicable for repair of vehicles/ equipment of Armed Forces (outsourcing head, through CDA) and as applicable for other Central/ State Govt Offices, as and when required.
- 13. The modalities of work for the assignment will be discussed and shared with the respondents of Eol.
- 14. <u>Eol Response Submission</u>. The response to Eol must be submitted as per the format at **Appendix** in a sealed cover or via email, on the address given below. The same must reach the following address on or before **1800 Hrs on 10 Oct 2020** in the following manner:

- 15. The eligible respondents will be intimated with respect to the schedule and modalities for interactions on the envisaged ESMW Scheme.

- 20. **No Legal Relationship**. No binding legal relationship will exist between any of the respondents and Indian Army until execution of a contractual agreement. Participation in the Eol process doesn't qualify for any contractual obligation from Indian Army.
- 21. <u>Notification</u>. Indian Army will notify all short-listed respondents in writing/ via email/ telephone, as soon as practicable about the outcome of the EoI process. Indian Army is not obliged to provide any reasons for any such acceptance or rejection.
- 22. This EoI is being invited with no financial commitment on part of the Govt of India/MoD.
