In Para 2 it is mentioned as 4500 metre above MSL, however, Para 3 (a) of Appendix A specifies altitude as 5500 metre. Please clarify.	The demonstration of equipment to deliver a minimum output of 750 litres per hour at an altitude of 4500 meters above mean sea level will be carried out. However, the head discharge table and derating upto 5500 metres shall be provided and equipment should function at 5500 metre altitude as per deration chart/ calculations submitted.
2	11	20	Integrity Pact Bank Guarantee	Is IPBG applicable for MSME also?	There is no exemption of IPBG for MSMEs. However, in case any exemption of IPBG from Govt for MSME is available with vendors, same may be quoted and supporting documents be provided.
